

A CALLED MEETING OF THE BRISTOL, VIRGINIA, CITY COUNCIL WAS HELD ON JULY 2ND, 2018, AT 9:00AM AT 300 LEE STREET, BRISTOL, VIRGINIA WITH MAYOR KEVIN MUMPOWER PRESIDING. COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT WERE VICE MAYOR KEVIN WINGARD, DOUG FLEENOR, WILLIAM HARTLEY, AND NEAL OSBORNE. INTERIM CITY MANAGER/CITY ATTORNEY, RANDALL EADS WAS ALSO PRESENT.

Mayor Mumpower called for a moment of silence followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

1. Oath of Office for Newly Elected Council Members by the Circuit Court Clerk.

Circuit Court Clerk Kelly Duffy provided the oath of office to new Council member Neal Osborne and re-elected Council members Kevin Wingard and Bill Hartley.

2. Appointment of City Clerk.

Mr. Wingard nominated Nicole Storm as City Clerk. The nomination was carried by the following votes:

3. Election of Mayor.

Mr. Wingard nominated Kevin Mumpower as Mayor. The nomination was carried by the following votes:

4. Election of Vice-Mayor.

Mr. Hartley nominated Kevin Wingard as Vice-Mayor. The nomination was carried by the following votes:

5. Appointment of City Manager.

Mr. Wingard nominated Mr. Randy Eads as City Manager. The nomination was carried by the following votes:

AYES: Fleenor, Hartley, Osborne, Wingard, Mumpower.

6. Appointment of City Attorney.

Mr. Wingard made a motion that Mr. Eads also serve as Interim City Attorney. The nomination was carried by the following votes:

AYES: Fleenor, Hartley, Osborne, Hartley, Wingard, Mumpower.

7. Closed Session.

Mayor Mumpower asked for a motion to go into closed session pursuant to §2.2-3711.A.1, Code of Virginia 1950, as amended. Discussion, consideration, or interviews of prospective candidates for employment; assignment, appointment, promotion, performance, demotion, salaries,

disciplining, or resignation of specific public officers, appointees, or employees of any public body; (Appointments). Mr. Hartley made the motion which was seconded by Mr. Wingard, and carried by the following votes:

AYES: Fleenor, Hartley, Osborne, Wingard, Mumpower.

Mayor Mumpower asked for a roll call to certify closed session.

Mayor Mumpower asked for a motion for the following appointments:

Mayor Mumpower said that other applicants would be interviewed at 3pm on July 5th at City Hall. These included applicants for the Industrial Development Authority and the Social Services Board.
