





The Cities of Bristol, Virginia, and Bristol, Tennessee, are seeking nominations for the 2015 Mayors' Award of Distinction, which recognizes individuals or organizations that have made extraordinary contributions towards the enhancement of the Bristol community.

These contributions can be in business, education, health and/or welfare of others, and arts and entertainment. Achievement of regional, national, or international recognition, while also positively promoting Bristol, will also be strongly considered. In order to be considered for nomination, individuals must have been born here, have lived or worked here, or demonstrate very strong ties to Bristol Tennessee/Virginia. Organizations to be considered must be able to demonstrate exceptional and highly beneficial service to the Bristol community. Self-nominations are welcomed. All nominations will be reviewed by an award panel comprised of members from civic and non-profit groups and the media. This panel will then choose the winner or winners of this prestigious award for the conferral by the Mayors.

The recipients will be the guests of honor at a community reception to be hosted May 11, 2015 from 6:30 to 8 pm at The Paramount Center for the Arts.

Deadline for submission is 5:30 pm, Monday, May 4, 2015.
PLEASE NOTE: Past winners are ineligible for repeat nomination.

BASIC NOMINATION GUIDELINES:

- Must have made a significant and lasting contribution to the Bristol Tennessee/ Virginia community
- Nominee was born, lives or works in, or who has strong ties with Bristol Tennessee /Virginia
- Nominee must be at least 25 years old
- Posthumous nominations will be accepted for a period of 24 months following the death
- Mayor's Award Panel members are not eligible to either nominate or be a recipient of an award while serving on the award panel
- Self-nominations are welcome
- Neither city personnel nor council members will be part of the process, nor part of the scoring or results
- The award is intended to recognize individuals, groups and actions that are performed on behalf of our community and the lives of people in our community
- Nominator must advise nominee of award entry, and have nominee's consent to submit.

1. Description of nominee's projects, activities or service and when these efforts occurred. Please attach up to two (2) pages.
2. Statement explaining why the nominee's contribution is particularly outstanding. Please attach up to one (1) page.
3. Supplemental materials - letters, brochures, etc. Maximum four (4) enclosures.
